**Sub : New Catering Policy 2010 - Repatriation of 188 Deemed
Deputationist Officials (DDOs) to Railways from IRCTC**

Consequent to framing of New Catering Policy-2010, in order to man the catering activities with experienced staff, instructions were issued to IRCTC as well as to Zonal Railways, vide Board's letter No. E(NG)I-2003/TR/10 dated 28.12.2010 and E(NG)I-2003/TR/10/Pt dated 27.06.2011 with advise to call for options from the Railways' catering staff who had not been paid any pensionary/retirement benefits due to administrative reasons, to come back to Railways with the seniority as existed as on 31.03.2003 subject to the condition that their consequential promotion should not lead to reversion of the existing catering staff and the redeployed staff. In response, a total of 188 deemed deputationists in IRCTC had exercised their option for repatriation to their respective parent Railways. Antecedents and service particulars of all these 188 DDOs have been verified by IRCTC in consultation with the concerned zonal Railway.

2. The matter has been considered by the Board who wish to approve the repatriation of all the above 188 DDOs to Railways on deputation terms as a special case treating their tenure with IRCTC as deemed deputation period. IRCTC will have to pay FSC charges to the concerned Railways for the intervening period as the same is to be counted as period on deputation for all purposes. The seniority of these staff in their respective parent cadre will be assigned as existed as on 31.03.2003 i.e. before their absorption in IRCTC. They will be eligible for all consequential promotion as per the revised percentage of posts issued vide Board's letter No. E(NG)I-2003/TR/10 dated 28.12.2010 (RBE No.187/2010) subject to the condition that consequential promotion of such repatriated employees should not lead to reversion of the existing catering staff and the redeployed staff.

3. IRCTC may initiate necessary action in this regard and parent Railway of the concerned employee may re-deploy them as per requirement of such trained employees. Service particulars of the concerned staff may be re-verified, if considered necessary.

Sub: Proposal to take options from the Railway catering staff absorbed
in IRCTC - New Catering Policy- 2010 Regarding.

Consequent to the issue of Catering Policy-2010 to man the catering activities on Indian Railways, orders were issued vide Railway Board's letter dated 28.12.2010 calling options from the catering staff absorbed in Railway establishment to come back to catering department.

2. In order to further augment manning the catering activities, the Board has decided, "in principle", to call for options from the Railway catering staff who had sought absorption in IRCTC but due to administrative reasons they could not be paid any pensionary/retirement benefits so far.

3. IRCTC may call options from the catering staff of Railways who had sought absorption in IRCTC but have not been paid any pensionary/retirement benefits, to come back to railways with the seniority as existed as on 31.03.2003 i.e. before their absorption in IRCTC. They will be eligible for all consequential promotions as per the revised percentage of posts issued vide RBE No. 187/2010 dated 28.12.2010. Their promotion, if any, will be given after completion of the promotion as envisaged in Board's letter dated 28.12.2010.

4. The options may be called from the Railway catering staff absorbed in IRCTC within 30 days and optees may be informed in writing that Board has accorded only "in principle" approval and the proposal is subject to final approval of the competent authority.
