Sub: Appointment on the Railways- Minimum educational qualification-
regarding.

Attention is invited to this Ministry's letter No. E(NG)II/-82/RC1/98 dated 1.9.1982 and No. E(NG)II-91/RC-1/117 (MC) dated 30.9.92 (RBE No. 164 of 1992), laying down instructions that 50% in Matriculation need not be insisted upon and candidates having a pass in Matriculation may be considered for appointment against physically handicapped quota as well as on compassionate grounds.

Board have recently issued guidelines enhancing the minimum educational qualification for various posts in Non-Technical Popular categories to 12th (+2 stage) or its equivalent examination with not less than 50% marks in aggregate.

References are being received from field units, seeking clarification whether in case of appointment against physically handicapped quota and of compassionate ground appointment, the candidates has to possess minimum of 50% in 12th (+2 stage).

The matter has been looked into and it has been decided by the Board that dispensation of non-insistence upon the 50% marks clause may be continued for such cases.

E(NG)II-82/RC 1/98 dated 01/09/1982

**Subject :- Appointment of physically handicapped persons
to Group 'C' posts - standard in Educational
qualifications.**

The Ministry of Railways in their letter No. E(NG)II-81/RSC/25 dated 25.01.1982 had prescribed that the minimum educational qualifications for recruitment to Group 'C' non-technical popular categories of posts other than ASMs and Guards should be a pass in matriculation or equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate. It has also been stated that for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen, this minimum percentage of 50% marks in matriculation need not be insisted upon.

A question has been raised as to whether in the case of appointment against handicapped quota, the candidate concerned has to possess minimum of 50% marks in matriculation. The matter has been considered and it is clarified that for appointment of handicapped persons against their quota to these posts, the minimum of 50% marks in matriculation need not be insisted upon and a pass in matriculation would do provided the other prescribed conditions are satisfied in their case.

**Subject :- Appointment on compassionate grounds –
Minimum educational qualification.**

Supplementary Circular No. 7 to Master Circular No. 16.

The following may be added in para VII of Master Circular No. 16 issued vide Board's letter of even number dated 12.12.1990.

"II (a) For compassionate appointment to the Non - Technical popular categories the minimum of 50% marks in Matriculation need not be insisted upon and candidates possessing a pass in Matriculation may also be appointed on compassionate grounds provided the other prescribed conditions are satisfied in their case."
