
With reference to the letters cited above Act Apprentices under Apprentices Act 1961 are being sent for medical examination with Bee-One medical classification to Railway Hospitals/Health Units. It has now been decided that the candidates should obtain medical certificate in the prescribed proforma (enclosed) as approved by CMD and CPO, from the Government Authorised Doctor's(Gazetted), not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon of Central / State Government Medical Services.

However, it is also to be specified in the notification that, 'Railway Administration has the right to send the selected candidates to any medical examination as deemed fit as a pre-appointment requisite.

This issues with the approval of CPO.

No evidence of Acute or chronic skin Disease or Chronic ulceration.

6. SPEECH:

Should be preferably perfect without Impediment

7. ALIMENTARY SYSTEM

- 1) Should have sufficient number of natural teeth (in Healthy State) for mastication
- 2) No oral sepsis.
- 3) Spleen should not be palpable
- 4) Liver should not be palpable

Others

Should not suffer from the following:

- a) Hemorrhoids
- b) Hernia/Hydrocele
- c) Bubonocele
- d) Ischio-rectal abscess

8. CARDIO VASCULAR SYSTEM

- i) Blood pressure should not exceed 85 diastolic and 140 systolic.
- ii) No sign of cardio vascular disease

9. RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

No deformity or chest causing impediment to breathing. Free from all disease of respiratory system

10. GENITO URINARY SYSTEM:

No Genitourinary disease or deformity

11. SKELETAL SYSTEM:

No evidence of serious deformity of the spinal column or of the extremities
The function of all limbs should be within normal limits.

12. NERVOUS SYSTEM:

No disease of Nervous system or any mental disease:

13. GLANDULAR SYSTEM:

No evidence of Tuberculosis or disease of Glandular System.

14. X'RAY OF LUNGS.

15. URINE SUGAR

16. BLOOD GROUP

The above named candidate is free from evidence of any contagious or infectious disease. The Act Appt are engaged and given training at Basic Training Centre for the periods shown against each as per Apprentices Act 1961. They are not being appointed to a regular post as employees.


In above ref 1 & 2, APO/G/MAS has quoted that the procedure for medical examination of Apprentices under the Apprentices Act 1961 is covered under Rule 4 and Schedule II of the Apprenticeship Rules, 1992 modifying the Apprentices Act 1961, copies of which are enclosed for ready reference

"In ICF, a medical certificate in the format prescribed by the Apprentices Act, has to be submitted by the apprentices duly certified by any Central/State Government Hospital Doctor not below the rank of Asst.Civil Surgeon of the State Medical Services, before being allowed to execute the contract of Apprenticeship." It is understood that apprentices recruited at ICF are not sent to Medical Department of ICF for examination.

It is brought to your kind attention that the Medical Examination schedule of Act Apprentice clashes with that done for candidates for Railway appointment at RII/PER, causing undue burden to the Hospital Authorities. In all such cases, preference has to be given to the candidates for Railway appointment

It is suggested that a similar exercise to that done by ICF may be carried out at Southern Railway also. The Act-Apprentices candidates may be advised to obtain Medical Certificate in appropriate format from any Central/State Government Hospital Doctor not below the rank of Asst.Civil Surgeon of the State Medical Services, before being allowed to execute the contract of Apprenticeship.

While offering remarks in connection with the suggestions called for by the Railway Board in engagement of apprentices under Apprentices Act, it was mentioned by this office that engagement of Act Apprentices is delayed very much due to the last preference being given to the Act Apprentices and the time taken by the medical authorities for examination for these candidates. To avoid this unnecessary delay, it was suggested that the candidates may be advised to submit medical certificate from authorized medical authority not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon (Gaz.) in the prescribed format as prescribed in the Apprentices Act at the time of actual engagement. Such a practice is being followed by the ICF administration. The MD/RH/PER had also suggested to follow the procedure adopted by the ICF as cited above. Copy of the MD/RH/PER letter dt. 28.05.14 and copy of the medical certificate being obtained by the ICF administration in this connection are also enclosed.

Approval may therefore be communicated for the above proposal so that the same could be incorporated in the notification calling for applications from candidates for engagement of Act Apprentices which is to be issued shortly by this office.
