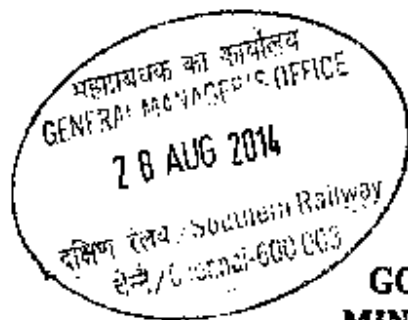

**Sub:** Clarification regarding prescribed educational qualification for the post of Health & Malaria Inspector, Grade-III in PB-2 (Grade Pay: ₹4200).

Minimum qualification for open market recruitment to post of Health & Malaria Inspector Gr.III has been laid down vide Board's letter of even number dated 30/5/2008(RBE No.68/2008). The qualification of B.Sc. (Chemistry) appearing therein, has been examined in consultation with Health Directorate of this Ministry on receipt of a reference from South Western Railway. Accordingly, ~~and~~ it is clarified that candidates who have studied Chemistry as main/optional subject in any branch of Chemistry while undertaking B.Sc. course shall be eligible for consideration for induction in railway service to the post of Health & Malaria Inspector, Grade-III, provided they are in possession of the requisite diploma qualification in Health/Sanitary Inspector as laid down vide letter *ibid*.

These instructions may be adhered to if such instances are reported in the panels forwarded/supplied by Railway Recruitment Boards.
