Sub: - Engagement of Contract Medical Practitioners (CMPs).


Please refer to Para 3 of Railway Board's letter No.96/E[GR]II/9/16 dated 21.08.2003 which stipulates that while engaging doctors on contract basis, representation of SC/ST and OBC categories as per vacancies reserved for them, should be ensured strictly.

In this context, a reference has been received from South Eastern Railway requesting to abolish the clause of SC/ST/OBC reservation from the guidelines for engagement of CMPs against the IRMS vacancies due to the difficulties being faced in getting the required CMPs at divisional headquarters like Chakradharpur and Adra in view of this clause and also on the plea that these engagements on contract basis can be terminated any time. The issue has been examined and it has been decided, with the approval of Board, that reservations for SC/STs & OBCs in engagement of CMPs cannot be done away with as CMPs are normally engaged for a period of one year at a time and as per DOP&T guidelines, reservations for SC/STs & OBCs should apply to all temporary appointments of more than 45 days.

Therefore, all Zonal Railways & Production Units are once again advised to scrupulously follow the instructions contained in Para 3 of Railway Board's letter No.96/E[GR]II/9/16 dated 21.08.2003.
