**विषय/Sub: Grant of Transport Allowance to Railway Employees-  
Extension of benefit of Transport Allowance at double the  
Normal Rates to Deaf and Dumb Employees -  
Implementation of the Order of the Apex Court -  
regarding.**

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A copy of Railway Board's letter No.PC-V/2014/A/TA/1 dated 19-03-2014 (RBE No. 28/2014) on the above subject is enclosed for information, guidance and necessary action.

In this connection, in view of instruction already available vide Board's letter dated 23-10-1978 & 12-09-2008 the following instructions are issued to have uniformity in processing the requests for grant of Transport Allowance to Deaf and Dumb Railway employees :-

- a) The applications requesting for grant of Transport Allowance at double the normal rates received from the Deaf and Dumb Railway Employees based on the Board's letter dt. 19-03-2014 cited above may be referred to the concerned Railway Hospitals for their recommendation. The recommendation of the ENT specialist of the Railway Hospital or Government Civil Hospital is very much essential / necessary before sanction of such Transport Allowance to the Deaf & Dumb employees.
- b) In terms of instructions contained in Railway Board's letter dt. 23-10-1978,12-09-2008 and 15-09-2008 the minimum degree of disability should be 40% in order to be eligible for any concession / benefit and

hence the minimum disability of 40% to such Railway Employees may be ensured while granting Transport Allowance.

- c) As indicated in Railway Board's letter dt. 23-10-1978 it shall be the responsibility of the officer who is empowered to sanction transport allowance to refer the cases of such Deaf & Dumb employees to the Railway medical authorities for obtaining their recommendation for the grant of such allowance.

The above instructions should be followed strictly without any deviation or violation.

**Sub:- Grant of Transport Allowance to Railway Employees—Extension of benefit of Transport Allowance at double the Normal Rates to Deaf and Dumb Employees – Implementation of the Order of the Apex Court – regarding.**

In compliance of the Order dated 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2013 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 107/2011 (Deaf Employees Welfare Association & Another V/s Union of India & Others), it has been decided to extend the benefit of Transport Allowance, as admissible to blind and orthopaedically handicapped employees in terms of para-2 (i) of Board's letter No.PC-V/2008/A/TA/2, dated 12.09.2008 (RBE No.111/2008), to deaf and dumb Railway Employees also, with immediate effect, subject to the condition that the recommendation of the Head of ENT Department of a Railway or Government Civil Hospital is received by the Head of Department and fulfillment of other conditions mentioned in Railway Board's letter No. F(E)I-78/AL-7/5, dated 23.10.1978 read with Board's letter dated 12.09.2008.



रिट याचिका (सिविल) सं. 107/2011 (बधिर कर्मचारी कल्याण संगठन एवं अन्य बनाम भारत संघ एवं अन्य) में दिनांक 12 दिसम्बर, 2013 के भारत के माननीय सर्वोच्च न्यायालय के आदेश के अनुपालन में दिनांक 12.09.2008 के बोर्ड के पत्र सं. पीसी-V/2008/ए/टीए/2 (आरबीई सं. 111/2008) के पैरा-2 (i) के अनुसार नेत्रहीन एवं ऑर्थोपेडिक रूप से विकलांग कर्मचारियों को यथा अनुमेय यातायात भत्ते का लाभ तत्काल प्रभाव से मूक एवं बधिर रेल कर्मचारियों को भी देने का विनिश्चय किया गया है बशर्ते कि विभागाध्यक्ष द्वारा रेलवे अथवा सरकारी सिविल अस्पताल के कान, नाक एवं गला विभाग के अध्यक्ष से सिफारिश प्राप्त हो और बोर्ड के दिनांक 12.09.2008 के पत्र के साथ पठित रेलवे बोर्ड के दिनांक 23.10.1978 के पत्र सं. एफ(ई)1-78/एएल-7/5 में उल्लिखित अन्य शर्तों को पूरा किया गया हो।
