In terms of Railway Board's letter cited above joining of RELHS-97 has been made mandatory for all those Railway Employees retiring from Railways without any exit clause whatsoever.


In this Railway two of the employees who voluntarily retired/retiring from service on 31-07-2012 & 30-09-2012 have represented that they may be exempted from joining RELHS-97 as they have already opted to avail medical facilities offered by Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) and Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) wherein her husband was/is employed and they have also stated that they did not wish to receive fixed Monthly Medical Allowance applicable to Railway pensioners.

In this connection, Railway Board is requested to clarify the following issues:

- 1) In case of employee where his/her spouse is working in other Central Government Organisations or Public Sector Undertakings and employee is willing to avail the medical facilities offered by such organisations on account of spouse, whether such Railway employee can be exempted from joining RELHS-97.
- 2) In case where both husband and wife are Railway employees whether any one of them can be exempted from joining RELHS-97 and allowing him or her to avail the medical facilities on spouse account in Railways.

Board are requested to examine the above issues and advise early.

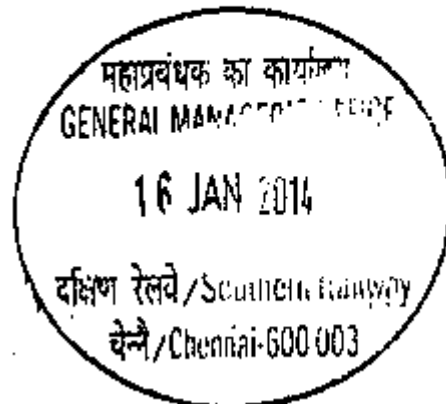
