Sub.: Clarification regarding conduct of medical re-examination of standby/waitlisted RRB candidates - for filling up additional/replacement vacancies of Zonal Railways and extension of currency of panel beyond two years under CEN No.01/2018 (ALPs & Technicians).

Instructions had been issued for filling up additional/replacement vacancies of Zonal Railways and extension of currency of panel beyond two years under CEN No.01/2018 (ALPs & Technicians) vide Board's letter of even number dated 03/06/2022 and letter No. 2022/E(RRB)/25/08 dated 07/06/2022.

2. Now, the following clarifications are issued regarding conducting of medical re-examination in respect of waitlisted/standby candidates:

SN	Case	Clarification
(a)	Where standby candidates are to be distributed to the Zonal Railway(s) being served by the RRB - on the basis of options already available.	(i) RRB to send the panel without seeking fresh option (for choice of Zonal Railway) or undertaking for medical re-examination. (ii) Undertaking to undergo medical re-examination may be taken from the candidates directly by the Zonal Railway concerned at the time of sending them for medical re-examination. (iii) Such standby candidates need not be called to the RRB.
(b)	Where standby candidates of the RRB are to be distributed to <u>only one other</u> Zonal Railway (i.e., irrespective of their options).	(Same as above)

(c)	Where standby candidates are to be distributed to <u>more than one other Zonal Railway</u> (i.e., other than the Zone being served by the RRB concerned).	<p>(i) RRB to send the panel(s) after obtaining fresh options (for choice of available Zonal Railway) from the standby candidates of the given community.</p> <p>(ii) Subsequently, undertaking to undergo medical re-examination may be taken from the candidates directly by the Zonal Railway concerned at the time of sending them for medical re-examination.</p> <p>(iii) Such standby candidates need not be called to the RRB.</p>
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3. Also the community wise numbers indicated in the letter have been obtained from RRBs. Any small variation in numbers already provided may be done by RRBs themselves duly advising Board and Railway.

4. According, para 2(vi) of Board's letter of even number and para 2(iii) of letter No.2022/E(RRB)/25/08 dated 07/06/2022, stands amended as brought out in para '2' above.

Sub: Requirement for filling up additional/replacement vacancies by Zonal Railways from standby/waitlisted candidates and extension of currency of panel beyond two years under CEN No. 01/2018 (Technicians).

Instructions were issued to all Zonal Railways vide Board's letter No.2022/E(RRB)/25/4 dated 14.05.2022 to review their requirement of Technicians and send proposal for extension of currency of panels for filling up of replacement vacancies and for filling up of additional vacancies from standby/waitlisted candidates available with RRBs for CEN-01/2018.

2. The proposals received from Zonal Railways for replacement and/or additional Technicians vacancies have been examined by Board as per provisions contained in RRB Manual and standby/waitlisted candidates available with RRBs. In order to meet the requirement of Zonal Railways in respect of Technicians, it has been decided to follow the following principles:

- (i) The requirement of the Zonal Railways for Technicians standby candidates/waitlisted candidates shall be met from that RRB which caters to the requirement of the Zonal Railway concerned.
- (ii) After exhausting the standby/waitlisted candidates available with the catering RRB, if there is still further requirement of the Zonal Railway, the same shall be met from other RRBs catering to the requirement of that Zonal Railway.
- (iii) Moreover, RRBs should also take an undertaking from such candidates that they will undergo medical examination again to ascertain their medical fitness (suitability) for the post. In case they are not found fit, their

candidature will not be considered. Their medical examination will be conducted by the respective Zonal Railways as per extant procedure. In case appeals are received for medical re-examination subsequently from candidates who are not found fit, those shall also be dealt as per extant rules.

3. The details of replacement as well as additional demands received in respect of Technicians for CEN- 01/2018 from Zonal Railways is as indicated below:


4. The following proposal is approved by Board:

- (i) Replacement demand of 186 Technicians received from ER, ECoR, NCR, RWF, SR & SECR as brought out above be fulfilled from standby/waitlisted candidates available first from the indented RRB and if indented RRB is not able to meet the demand then any of the RRBs catering to the concerned Zonal Railway.
- (ii) The additional demand of 1723 Technicians received from CR, ECoR, NCR, NFR, RWF, SECR, SWR, WR & WCR as brought out above be fulfilled from any of the RRBs that

cater to Zonal Railway depending upon availability of standby candidates with concerned RRB in category demanded by Railway.

- (iii) It has also decided that the validity of GEN-01/2018 be extended by one year from the date of expiry of the panel as advised by RRBs for considering replacement/additional demands as indicated above.

5. Immediate action as above may be taken by Zonal Railways in consultation with RRBs and the position be advised for information of Board.

Sub: Requirement for filling up additional/replacement vacancies by Zonal Railways from standby/waitlisted candidates and extension of currency of panel beyond two years under GEN No. 01/2018 (ALPs).

Instructions were issued to all Zonal Railways vide Board's letter No.2022/E(RRB)/25/4 dated 14.05.2022 to review their requirement of ALPs and send proposal for extension of currency of panels for filling up of replacement vacancies and for filling up of additional vacancies from standby/waitlisted candidates available with RRBs for GEN-01/2018.

2. The proposals received from Zonal Railways for replacement and/or additional ALP vacancies have been examined by Board as per provisions contained in RRB Manual and standby/waitlisted candidates available with RRBs. In order to meet the requirement of Zonal Railways in respect of ALPs, it has been decided to follow the following principles:

- (i) The requirement of the Zonal Railways for ALP standby candidates/waitlisted candidates shall be met from that RRB which caters to the requirement of the Zonal Railway concerned.
- (ii) After exhausting the standby/waitlisted candidates available with the catering RRB, if there is still further requirement of the Zonal Railway, the same shall be met from other RRBs catering to the requirement of that Zonal Railway.
- (iii) In case no standby/waitlisted candidate is available with the RRB/s under the jurisdiction of the Zonal Railway, the requirement shall be met from other RRBs having excess waitlisted/standby ALP candidates.
- (iv) While allotting ALPs to Zonal Railways, merit list/community/candidate preference should be ensured by RRBs.
- (v) Before empanelment, options should be taken from the standby/waitlisted candidates by RRBs regarding their 1st/2nd/3rd choice for Zonal Railway. Empanelment and allotment will be decided by RRBs based on their merit and community.

- (vi) Moreover, RRBs should also take an undertaking from such candidates that they will undergo medical examination again to ascertain their medical fitness (suitability) for the post. In case they are not found fit, their candidature will not be considered. Their medical examination will be conducted by the respective Zonal Railways as per extant procedure. In case appeals are received for medical re-examination subsequently from candidates who are not found fit, those shall also be dealt as per extant rules.

3. Board has decided that the validity of CEN-01/2018 be extended by one year from the date of expiry of the panel as advised by RRBs. As demand of Zonal Railways cannot be met from RRBs within their jurisdiction, Board has decided to meet excess demand for standby/waitlisted candidates available with other RRBs. Distribution has been decided keeping in view community-wise demand and availability with RRBs and geographical locations of RRBs and Zonal Railways. The details of standby candidates in respect of ALPs for CEN-01/2018 available with RRBs has been distributed as per demand received from Zonal Railways as indicated below:

4. The demand for replacement should be exhausted before empanelling candidates against additional demand. If any RRB is still having any standby candidates not indicated in the above distribution, the same may be distributed by RRBs against the unmet demand so that no standby candidate, who is otherwise eligible, is left waiting for appointment.

5. Immediate action as above, be taken by all RRBs in consultation with the Zonal Railways and position be advised for information of Board.
