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In partial modification of their instructions in para (xi) of Boards letter dated 31/08/2015 (Ref. No.1 above) on the comprehensive transfer policy, Railway Board vide letter dated 10-02-2017(RBE 12/2017, PBC 17/17) has stated that the under mentioned type of transfers will be exempted from the condition of five years rule for Inter Railway Transfer:


1. Transfer sought on mutual exchange.
2. Transfer sought on Spouse Account.
3. Railway Servants who are care givers to a disabled child.
4. Physically handicapped Railway Servant.

The subject regarding relaxation of minimum service condition on Inter Divisional Transfer requests was discussed in the PNM meeting held on 22/3/19 and 23/3/2019 by the General Manager with the representatives of SRMU as subject No. 7(B) 2019. As per PBC 13 / 2013 (Ref No. 2) requests for IDTs on Spouse Ground are being considered in the ratio of 1:3 between Spouse & General requests

The issue raised by SRMU for relaxing the minimum service condition of three years for Inter Divisional Transfer requests, has been examined.

There are large numbers of IDT requests pending in all divisions/workshops on general grounds. To keep a balance between IDTs on general grounds and the categories exempted under item 2 to 4 of Railway Board's letter dated 10.02.2017, a ratio of 1 : 3 between the categories under item 2 to 4 of Board's letter dated 10.02.2017 and that of general grounds is to be followed while considering IDT requests. In respect of mutual transfers mentioned under item 1 of Board's letter, no exemption is required as the requests are being considered one to one basis.
