**विषय/Sub: Minimum period of Service for eligibility for promotion
within Group 'C'.**


One of the Workshops has raised a query as to whether the two years residency period is necessary for promotion for posts carrying Grade Pay from GP Rs. 1800 to GP Rs. 1900.

The issue was examined in detail in the light of implementation of VI CPC recommendations and introduction of Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008, wherein all the Group 'D' services in Railways have been abolished, consequent of which all the employees holding Group 'D' posts as on 01-01-2006 have been placed under Group 'C' services.

Further, the Railway Board have issued revised classification of services vide letter dated 8-01-2010 (PBC No. 4/2010) wherein a Railway Service post carrying Grade Pay Rs. 4600 and Rs. 4200 in Pay Band PB-2 (Rs.9300-34800), Grade Pay 2800, Rs. 2400, Rs. 2000, Rs.1900 and Rs.1800 in Pay Band PB-1 (5200-20200) are classified under Gr. 'C' services.

In view of above revised classification of Services, the erstwhile Gr 'D' employees who are now placed with Grade Pay Rs.1800 have come under Group 'C' services, and therefore, the condition of minimum 2 years residency period in the immediate lower grade for eligibility for further promotion within Gr-C as specified in Board's letter dated 19-02-87 (PBC-52/87) is required to be followed for promotion from GP 1800 to 1900 also.

This has the approval of CPO.
