Sub:- Promotion of X-Ray Attendant and other staff to the post of Radiographer (L-5) GP Rs.2800.

Pursuant to the recommendations of Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB), the minimum educational qualification to fill up the post of Radiographers in PB-IRs 5200-20200 GP Rs.2800 (L-5) against 50% promotion quota from amongst serving Railway employees was, revised from Matriculation with Physics and Chemistry & possessing Diploma in X-Ray Technician's Course from a recognized Institute to 10+2 or equivalent examination passed with Science subject from a recognized Board and Radiographers/X-Ray Technologist course of minimum one year duration (including in field training in diagnostic radiology) vide Board's letter No.E(NG)I-2003/PX110-4 dated 0.2.12.2011.

- NEIR, in its agenda Item No.51/2016, have raised a demand in the PNM Meeting that possibility may be explored to impart training to existing staff who do not possess the requisite qualifications presently for further promotion, to make them eligible for consideration for such further promotion subject to fulfillment of all other eligibility conditions.
- The matter has accordingly been considered in consultation with the Health and Finance Directorates of Railway Board. It has been decided that X-Ray Attendants recruited with pre-revised qualification may be encouraged/granted study leave to acquire the requisite qualification from a recognised institution either through distance learning or by joining a course of study on regular basis. On acquiring of such qualification they will be eligible for consideration for promotion as per their turn, otherwise gligible. The Zonal Railways accordingly may consider request of employees in question tayourably for grant of study leave as per the extant rules.

Subject: Modification in qualification to the post of Radiographer in PB-1 Rs. 5200-20200 GP Rs. 2800 in Medical Department-Amendment to IREM.

Vol. I, First Re-print Edition-2009-regarding.

[No. E(NG)1-2003/PM 10/4, dated 2.12.2011]

As the Railways are aware, in terms of Para 164(1) (ii) of IREM Vol. I, First Re-print Edition 2009, the vacancies in the grade of Radiographers in PB-1 Rs. 5200-20,200 GP Rs. 2800 against 50% promotional quota are filled by selection from amongst staff in PB-1 GP Rs. 1800 working as X-Ray Attendant possessing the qualification of Matriculation with Physics and Chemistry; those possessing Diploma in X-Ray Technician's Course from a recognized Institute, should have put in a minimum of two years service and others a minumum of five years Railway service to be eligible for promotion. In the event of shortfall against the quotathe posts remaining unfilled will not be carried forward and will be filled by direct recruitment.

2. Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) has laid down minimum educational qualification for X-Ray Technologists, as mentioned below, with stipulation that it is mandatory for all medical X-Ray installation to follow this requirement:——

(i) 10+2 or equivalent examination passed with science subjects from a recognised Board; and

- (ii) Radiographers /X-Ray Technologist course of minimum one year duration (including in field training in diagnostic radiology) passed from a recognized institution.
- In the light of the above developments, the matter has been considered by Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) in consultation with its Health Directorate and it has been decided to adopt the modified educational qualification, as recommended by AERB mentioned above, for implementation on the Railways to fill up the post of Radiographers X-Ray Technicians in Pay Band-I Rs. 5200-20200 Grade Pay Rs. 2800 against 50% promotional quota. Other terms and conditions as laid down for the purpose will remain unaltered.
