

**Sub: Engagement of retired para-medical staff (in Group 'C') and hiring of para-medical staff (in Group 'C') on contract basis.**

Since the alarming situation owing to outbreak of COVID-19 continues unabated, it has been decided to extend the scheme of hiring of para-medical staff (in Group 'C') on contract basis within the sanctioned strength (which was valid upto 30.09.2020) and also over and above the sanctioned strength (which was valid upto 30.06.2020) **upto 31.12.2020** subject to the stipulations already mentioned in Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dated 18.03.2020 for the former and Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dated 31.03.2020 for the latter respectively.

2. It has also been decided to extend the validity of scheme for engaging retired employees (which is presently valid upto 01.12.2020) **upto 31.12.2020 for engaging retired para-medical staff only** subject to the stipulations contained in Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2007/RC-4/CORE/1 dated 28.11.2019. As regards the arrangement put in place vide Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dated 31.03.2020 for the engagement of **retired para-medical staff** over and above the sanctioned strength of the cadre depending on the requirement, it has been decided to extend this arrangement also **upto 31.12.2020** subject to the stipulations already mentioned in Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dated 31.03.2020 as has been decided in case of hiring of para-medical staff (in Group 'C') on contract basis.

3. Extension of these schemes upto **31.12.2020** for engagement of retired para-medical staff and hiring of para-medical staff on contract basis (in Group 'C') shall be effective from 01.07.2020.

**Sub:** Engagement of para-medical categories in Group 'C' on contract basis.

**Ref:** Railway Board's letter of even No. dated 28.03.2020.

Keeping in view the outbreak of Corona Virus disease, it was decided to authorise General Manager/CAO/DRMs to engage retired Paramedical staff up to age of 65 years or to hire Paramedical staff on Contract basis for a period of one month over and above the sanctioned strength of the cadre depending upon the requirement vide Board's above referred letter as a purely temporary measure with stipulation that after one month, the *status quo ante* will be restored with regard to total strength and delegation of power unless extended by further orders.

2. However, since the alarming situation owing to outbreak of Corona Virus disease continues to be unabated, it has been decided to hire the retired Paramedical staff up to the age of 65 years or to hire Paramedical staff on Contract basis for a period of three months instead of one month as decided vide Board's earlier letter dated 28.03.2020 with stipulation that after expiry of three months, the *status quo ante* will be restored with regard to total strength and delegation of power unless extended by further orders. The mode of engagement may be decided by the General Manager/CAO.

3. The concurrence of the Associate Finance at Railway/PU/Divisional Level may be obtained before resorting to engagement in terms of these instructions.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board).

**Sub: Engagement of para-medical categories in Group 'C' on contract basis.**

Keeping in view the outbreak of Corona Virus disease, instructions had been issued vide Board's letter of even No. dated 18.03.2020 extending the Scheme of hiring of Paramedical Categories in Group 'C' on Contract basis for a further period of six months beyond 31.03.2020, i.e. upto 30.09.2020 subject to stipulation that total regular staff on roll and contractual engagement will not exceed the sanctioned strength of the cadre.

2. Keeping in view the pandemic situation because of the outbreak of Corona Virus disease, it is apprehended that extra Paramedical staff will be required for handling the enormous rush expected in few weeks. Therefore, to meet the situation, it has been decided to authorise General Manager/CAO/DRMs to engage retired Paramedical staff up to age of 65 years or to hire Paramedical staff on Contract basis for a period of one month over and above the sanctioned strength of the cadre depending upon the requirement. This is purely a temporary measure and after expiry of one month, the *status quo ante* will be restored with regard to total strength and delegation of power unless extended by further orders.

3. The concurrence of the Associate Finance at Railway/PU/Divisional Level may be obtained before resorting to engagement in terms of these instructions.

4. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board).
