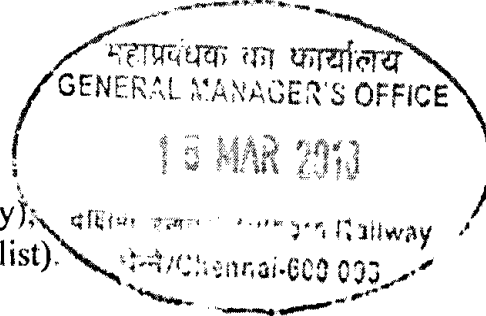

Sub: Allotment/retention of Railway quarter to the wards of Railway employees recruited under the LARSGESS Scheme on the Railways.

The policy regarding allotment/retention of Railway quarter to wards of Railways employees recruited under the LARSGESS Scheme as notified at the launch of the Scheme and mentioned at para 2(xv) of the Board's letter dated 02.01.2004 referred to above was subsequently revised in terms of Railway Board's letter dated 21.02.2014 thereby prescribing that "quarters occupied by the employees taking VRS under the LARGESS Scheme may be allowed retention of accommodation in the name of only those wards who are eligible for the same type of accommodation and for others, the wards may be considered for a fresh allotment as per their entitlement on out of turn basis".

2. In the context of above policy revision it may please be advised whether there were any number of employees on your Railway appointed/recruited under the LARSGESS Scheme prior to 21.02.2014 who were waiting for allotment/retention of Railway quarter as per the previous policy of letter dated 02.01.2004 prescribing allotment/retention on own turn and if so, how were such cases dealt with and decided upon revision of policy vide Board's letter dated 21.02.2014 laying down out of turn allotment/retention of Railway quarter to LARSGESS recruits.

3. An early reply by 12th March, 2018 will be appreciated.
