Sub: Reckoning of erstwhile GP 4200, Pay Level 6 as initial entry grade for granting financial upgradation under MACP Scheme to the Station Masters category.

The matter referred vide Central Railway's letter under reference has been examined in Board's office and in this regard it has been observed that as per Note-2 of Annexure-B of Board's letter dated 2/8/16, the post of ASMs in GP 2800 has been abolished by way of upgradation of the said post to grade pay of 4200 (now pay level 6) and merged with the SMs in GP 4200 along with functions. It has further been observed that the post of SM in GP 4200 was the next higher functional post for promotion of ASMs. Further, vide Item No. 31 of Board's letter No. PC-V/99/1/1/1 dated 19/2/02, it has been clarified that where the placement in a higher grade involves assumption of higher duties and responsibilities then such upgradation will be viewed as promotions/upgradation

In view of the above, the upgradation of ASMs in GP 2800 to the post of SMs in the GP 4200 has to be counted for the purpose of MACPS and therefore the grade pay of Rs. 4200 (now pay level 6) cannot be treated as entry grade for the purpose of MACPs in respect of incumbent ASMs who have been directly recruited as ASM in G.P. 2800.
