2.0 Eligibility:

- Candidates working in Pay Matrix of Level-7 (GP Rs.4600/-) and one Pay Matrix below
 i.e. Level-6 of GP Rs.4200/- (not under MACP), are eligible to apply.
- The candidate should have completed at least 07 (Seven) years of service in Operating/Commercial Department (as on the date of this notification).
 - Those who have already completed their tenure in Vigilance or have been repatriated from Vigilance Branch are <u>NOT</u> eligible to apply for the post.
- The candidate should have good experience in the Commercial / Operating Departments.
- The candidate should preferably have command over different languages on the areas covered by this Railway.
 - · The candidate should have sound integrity. Also,
 - Candidates should have clear Vigilance history and should not have undergone any penalty in Vigilance/ SPE case.
 - The candidate should not have undergone any penalty under D&AR during the last 3 years from the date of this notification.

2.1 Procedure for Submission of Application:

 Applications should be submitted in the prescribed pro-forma enclosed herewith, and same should be forwarded through proper channel. <u>Applications received through</u>
 'PROPER CHANNEL' alone will be considered. It may be noted that the applications received directly from the candidate will not be considered for the selection.

2.3 It may be noted that such advance copy of the applications shall not be considered for the selection, if the candidate's application is NOT received through 'PROPER CHANNEL' on or before the last date for submission of the application.

3.0 It is clarified that the ADVANCE COPY of the application shall not be accepted by Hand or Courier or Registered/Speed post.

- Applications, as per enclosed pro-forma must be neatly and unambiguously filled in and signed by the candidate himself/herself, giving the correct information to the best of his/her knowledge. No alterations/corrections on the application will be entertained at a later stage. Applicants must note that if any information furnished by him/her is found to be false at any stage, the application/candidature will be liable to be rejected.
- Submission of false or misleading information by the applicant is liable for D&AR action against him/ her.
- Attested copies of updated Service Registers (SRs) and APARs of the candidates for the years ending on 31.03.2022, 31.03.2021 & 31.03.2020 may please be sent to this office along with their applications.
- The applications should reach to The Office of the Chief Vigilance Officer, Southern Railway, 7th Floor, CAO/CN/MS Complex, Egmore, Chennai–600008 on or before 08.03.2023, duly forwarded through PROPER CHANNEL. Applications received after this date will be rejected.

4.0 Selection Procedure:

- The selection process will comprise of Suitability Test being conducted by Vigilance Organisation. The Suitability Test shall include:
 - b) Written Test
 - b) Vigilance Aptitude Test and
 - c) Computer Knowledge Test

- Performance Grading as per Last three years of APAR will be considered.
- Candidates who obtain at least 60% marks in written test will only be called for Vigilance Aptitude Test and Computer Knowledge Test.
- Questions in written test may be asked from Railway Services D&A Rules, 1968, Railway Service (Conduct) Rules-1966, Establishment matters including Rajbhasha, General awareness, matters pertaining to Operating & Commercial Departments, etc.

5.0 General Conditions

- The tenure of the post is Three (3) years, which may be extended as per extant rule on case to case basis depending on the requirement.
- On completion of the tenure, the candidates will be repatriated to the respective parent cadre on the Railway where he/she holds lien. However, the candidates selected for the post could be repatriated at any time, on or before completion of the tenure without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- The candidate should have good reputation and possess good drafting ability.
- The Vigilance work is mainly outdoor involving extensive travelling. The candidate should be prepared for the same and should have physical fitness for the same.
- The candidate should possess sufficient knowledge of Railway Services (Conduct) Rules and Railway Servants (Discipline and Appeal) Rules, other Codal Provisions and in their professional matters.
- The selected candidates may be repatriated to his/her parent department if it becomes necessary for the administration, or if he/she gets selected for any higher grade post.
- The candidate who has been selected should be relieved immediately in the event of his/her selection as CVI.
- The date of written test will be intimated to eligible candidates later.
- No supplementary selection will be held.
- Once selected, applicants will not be permitted to withdraw and refuse posting in Vigilance Department.
- Those candidates who express unwillingness after being selected, an entry will be made in the Service Register.
- 6.0 It is requested to give wide publicity for this notification, so that eligible candidates can benefit from this. As per extant Board's directives wide publicity of this Selection notification must be given among SC/ST candidates to encourage their participation.
- 7.0 Applications of employees who have not undergone any penalty in a Vigilance / SPE case during their service period, and of employees who have not undergone any penalty under DAR in the last 3 years from the date of this notification, should only be forwarded.

8.0 Concerned Controlling Office/Personnel Branch should forward the 'eligible' applications, duly filled and complete in all respects, to Vigilance Organisation/Southern Railway along with attested copies of Service Register and APARs, so as to reach the same in the Office of Chief Vigilance Officer, Southern Railway, 7th Floor, CAO/CN Office Complex, Egmore, Chennai-600008 positively on or before 08.03.2023.
