The above appointment is subject to the following conditions.

1. The existing Railway Services (Pension) Rules, 1993 including commutation of Pension Rules and Extraordinary Pension Rules, and State Railway Provident Fund Rules as contained in Indian Railway Establishment Code/Vol.I (1985 edition) 1995 reprint, shall not be applicable to the above named newly recruited / appointed candidates. For the purpose of leave, they will be governed by the leave rules as admissible and as corrected from time to time. They are covered under the newly introduced restructured defined contribution pension system (RBE No.225/2003). Newly recruited person, who joins service on or after 1st day of April 2025 may exercise option to be covered under Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) within thirty days from the date of joining Central Government services or within such extended timelines, if any, allowed by the Central Government. The option once exercised shall be final and irrevocable and new recruited person, who does not exercise the Unified Pension Scheme (UPS) option under National Pension Scheme (NPS) within the timelines laid down, shall be deemed to have opted to continue under NPS without UPS Option.

6. He will be held responsible for the care of Government money, goods and stores and any other property that may be entrusted to his care in the discharge of his official duties.

7. He will be liable to Military service in Railways or the Territorial Army for a period as may be amended for such period from time to time.

8. His lien will be maintained at the Headquarters.

9. His 'Seniority' will be determined on the basis of rank assigned by the Railway Recruitment Board, and his earlier appointment will not confer on him any claim for 'Seniority' over those who are placed above him in the panel as well as over those who are in the recruitment panel of Railway Recruitment Board.

10. His continuance in service is subject to:

- a. Qualifying for the duties prescribed for the post he holds.
- b. Fulfilling such other general conditions of service as may be laid down from time to time.
- c. Being prepared to serve anywhere on the Southern Railway and
- d. Compliance to all rules and regulations as applicable to his appointment.

11. He should produce Bank Account No., AADHAAR No. and PAN No. to claim his salary on his appointment.

12. His appointment is provisional subject to the receipt of verification report from Civil / Police authorities regarding his character and antecedents. If anything adverse in the said report is found regarding suitability for appointment, please note that his services is liable to be terminated. This has the approval of Competent Authority viz., CMS /DRH /GOC.

13. The date of joining should be advised to this office immediately.
